## EARLY YEARS

<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> 	<p><b>READING/WRITING:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children should spend a minimum of 10 minutes a day reading aloud – a book at their level. You will find that <a href="https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page/">https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page/</a> has suitable e- books. When you enter the page, scroll down to 'Browse the Library', select 'level' and then the book band your child is currently on. This will provide you with a range of books.</li><li>• Please also read other stories with your child for a minimum of 10 minutes a day. Please share a range of stories and information books.</li><li>• Please help your child to read/recognise the high frequency words list (attached)</li><li>• Please practise handwriting in their specific handwriting books. Ensure your child has the correct pinch grip. Please use the formation poems to aid correct formation.</li></ul>
<p><b>MATHS/NUMBER</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Work on Maths Passports (children have them in their book bags) which teach basic number skills</li><li>• Play board games which involve counting</li><li>• Play games such as Hopscotch in the garden</li><li>• Look for opportunities to count/add/subtract around the home</li><li>• Visit <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/</a> for online games. Select 'Learning Games' once you enter the website.</li></ul>
<p><b>FOUNDATION LEARNING</b></p> <p>Where a project is mentioned, children can complete this in any way they choose. This could be a piece of artwork, a model or a piece of writing. Some children might even create a piece of music, a song or a poem!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Parents are asked to support their child to do a mini project on: TRADITIONAL STORIES.</li><li>• Parents could also support their child to create a mini project on either:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An animal of my choice</li><li>• My family</li><li>• Where I live</li></ul></li></ul>



All projects should include some form of writing: this can be labels, phrases, simple sentences or stories.
