ENGLISH



READING:

- Children should spend 10 minutes a day reading aloud – a book at their reading colour level. You will find that the Oxford Owl website has suitable ebooks.
- Please also read to/with your child for 10 minutes a day. Please share a range of story and information books.
- Please help your child to read the high frequency words list (attached).
- Inside the Home/School Reading booklet are some Phonics pages which you may find useful to show the graphemes which your child has been learning to read.
- We have sent home some spellings sheets for the children to complete one each week.
 They can also continue to learn to spell the Year 1 common exception words.
- We have also sent home a Common Exceptions Words Activity Booklet ...maybe one or two each week

MATHS/NUMBER



- Please continue to work on Maths Passports which teach basic number skills. We are sending home the next Maths Passport too so your child can move onto it when they are ready.
- Play board games and other games which involve counting or using dice eg Snakes and Ladders
- Play games such as Hopscotch if you have access to an outside space
- Look for opportunities to count/add/subtract around the home
- Help your child to recognise a 12 hour analogue clock face and learn to read o'clock and half past times
- We are sending home a few Maths activity sheets as well to give you some more ideas – maybe try a couple each week.

	 https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ is a good Maths website . Caterpillar ordering and Hit the Button are great activities to support your child's Maths learning. All children have a Mathletics login too and they are welcome to explore the Maths activities on this. Currently we are not setting tasks on this but we may do in due course.
FOUNDATION LEARNING	 Please help your child to discover/learn and enjoy some TRADITIONAL STORIES. Eg The Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Enormous Turnip, The Gingerbread Man etc. The children could make some puppet characters, act the stories out, rewrite a story in their writing book, illustrate the stories. We would also like you to help your child find out about one of the following and produce a piece of learning about it. It could be a booklet, a fact sheet, a piece of writing, a model, some artwork: An animal of my choice My family Where I live
Other information	 We have sent home a writing book and a plain book for you to use to support your child's learning. The children could decorate the covers and hopefully they will enjoy having these learning journals to write and draw in. We would love to see the books when the children come back to school. Your child also has their Purplemash login. We may set activities for the children to do on this. These can be found on the red 2Dos button BBC Supermovers KS1 (see link below) is also great for being active whilst learning. We use it lots at school so your child already knows it well. Your child also needs to enjoy lots of time just exploring, creating and discovering. Junk modelling, cutting up magazines, sorting anything, colouring, cutting and sticking, cooking, playing
