You will find that <b>the Oxford Owl website</b> has suitable e- books</li> <li>• Please also read to/with your child for a minimum of 15 minutes a day. Please share a range of story and information books.</li> <li>• Please make sure that you discuss the book with your child – focusing on the characters, plot and vocabulary. Comprehension is key to fluency.</li> <li>• Please help your child to read and spell the Y1/Y2 expected spellings.</li> <li>• <b>Readiwriter Spelling</b> - We have set spelling lists on Readiwriter and these will be updated regularly. To login you need to go to the <b>Readiwriter</b> homepage and enter a pupil's <b>Mathletics</b> Username and Password.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MATHS/NUMBER</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work on <b>Maths Passports</b> which teach basic number skills</li> <li>• Play board games which involve counting and using two dice</li> <li>• <b>Mathletics</b> will be set on a Friday - please check regularly</li> <li>• Please look for opportunities to read time on an analogue clock and use the four operations around the home (+ - x ÷)</li> </ul>
