- Please make sure that you discuss the book with your child – focusing on the characters, plot and vocabulary.

MATHS/NUMBER



- Work on **Maths Passports** which reinforce basic number skills
- Play board games which involve counting and using two dice
- Practise times tables – need to know fluently
- **Mathletics** will be set on a Friday - please check regularly
- Please look for opportunities to practise time/weights and measure around the home.
