- Children should spend a minimum of 20 minutes a day reading aloud – a book at their level. You will find that **the Oxford Owl website** has suitable e- books
- Please also read to/with your child for a minimum of 15 minutes a day. Please share a range of story and information books.
- Please make sure that you discuss the book with your child – focusing on the characters, plot and vocabulary.
- Work on the Y3/Y4 statutory spellings list – learn those highlighted at the back of your book and use strategies that work for you!
- **Readiwriter Spelling** - We have set spelling lists on Readiwriter and these will be updated regularly. To login you need to go to the **Readiwriter** homepage and enter a pupil's **Mathletics** Username and Password.
- Draw and design your own dragon
- Create a comprehensive booklet (4 sheets folded) which is a guide to living with your pet dragon, based on **The Boy Who Lived with Dragons**
 - Draw and design your own dragon and name it
 - Create a story about the adventures of your dragon with appropriate diagrams, cartoons, pictures of your choice

MATHS

- Work on **Maths Passports** which practise basic number skills



- Use Purple Mash to practise your tables – all Y4 pupils need to know up to 12x fluently
- Play the following maths games on Purple Mash: Fraction Wall, Fractonio's Pizzeria, Dividers, Facteroids, Bond Bubbles.
- Use Topmarks.co.uk (Daily 10, Hit the Button) to practise
- Use Hit the Button for tables, halving, doubling and number bonds
- **Mathletics** will be set on a Friday - please check regularly
- Please look for opportunities to practise time/weights and measure around the home.

SCIENCE



On Purple Mash, look at Healthy Teeth which can be found under: Science – Human Body. Complete the Healthy Teeth quiz which is found in the same section.

Create a leaflet to give advice on how to look after your teeth.

Look at the role of each type of human teeth and link the role to the types of food we eat. Now research different animals and the types of teeth they have. How do they differ from our teeth? Make links between the type of teeth they have and the food they eat.

Create a zine using this information for our Science board.

FOUNDATION LEARNING

Where a project is mentioned, children can complete this in any way they choose. This could be a piece of artwork, a model or a piece of writing. Some children might even create a piece of music, a song or a poem!



Please prepare a project on at least one of the following:

- History - Civil War

Write a **character profile** and a **diary entry** for **Oliver Cromwell** after one of the major battles in the Civil War e.g. Battle of Naseby 1645 or Battle of Marston Moor

- Geography - Alice Holt

Create a tourist guide with maps and activities that are available
