- Children should spend a minimum of 30 minutes a day reading aloud – a book at their level. You will find e- books and audio books available online-**Try Oxford Owl website**
- Please make sure that you discuss the book with your child – focusing on the characters, plot and vocabulary. Comprehension is key.
- We will be expecting children to complete a detailed book review or author study of their choice.
- Please support your child to spell the words on the Y5/Y6 statutory spellings list (attached). As well as being able to spell, children need to know the meaning of the words and be able to use them in context.
- **Collins Revision Books for SATS** Please work through any pages not completed in the Grammar & Spelling book. These books are still relevant as they cover the content that children are expected to know before secondary.
- **Readiwriter Spelling** - We have set spelling lists on Readiwriter and these will be updated regularly. To login you need to go to the **Readiwriter** homepage and enter a pupil's **Mathletics** Username and Password.

- Maths passports – to reinforce basic skills.
- Complete pages in the **Collins Revision** Maths study guide.
- **Mathletics** will be set regularly and monitored by class teachers.
