## **Easter RE Year Five**

This is a mainly a 'deep' thinking task, following on from what you've been learning in class. You will already have explored some of these ideas.



Bellini – The agony in the garden

You all know the Easter Story – but this asks questions. Why did Jesus die? Who was really responsible? What did His death mean for Christians?

- Please look at the PDF attachment (it was impossible to download only the bits you need). Remind yourself of The Stations of the Cross by reading pages 38 and 39.
- 2. You may like to look at some of the famous artwork suggested on page 40.
- 3. Your task is to complete the Responsibility Pie on page 41 (print out or draw your own). There's no right or wrong answer.
- 4. Read the situations on page 42 maybe discuss your thoughts with an adult or older sibling. Compare them with the ideas on page 43.
- 5. Move on to page 45 and use the sentence starters to write your own short piece on what you think about Jesus' death as a sacrifice.

This is quite a challenging piece of work – take your time to think and talk. You will find that adults also find it challenging. Remember that Jesus' death and the concept of Salvation is a key concept for Christians around the world.

Keep your thoughts as this unit leads into the learning you'll be doing around Easter in Y6.
