

What you will need:

6 x 750g -1.5kg bags of table salt (depending on how much salt is required) 6 bottles of different coloured paint 6 large mixing bowls A mixing spoon



Follow these steps to make coloured salt





Use the outlines or draw your own rangoli outline on a paper plate. You can use pencil or felt pens to do this.



Start in the middle and paint a thick layer of PVA glue on the plate, in one section.




Carefully spoon some coloured salt onto the glue, trying to keep it in the section.



Pat down the salt using the back of the spoon until the section is filled.



Add more coloured salt to the smaller sections and use your fingers to spread it around.




Continue doing this until your design is all filled in.




You might like to paint the outside edge or continue using the salt to finish the rangoli.



You could add some sequins or even real flowers to your design. Simple rangoli outlines







Rangoli patterns are not always in a circle shape. They can be in a shape of an animal, half circle, triangle, star, flower or can even be a scene. You may like to try one of these too.

You can make your name into a rangoli pattern:

Cut out a rectangular piece of cardboard, big enough to glue the letters of your name across it. (templates on next 2 slides).

Once you have glued down your letters, you can use a pencil to create simple patterns in each letter.

Choose different salt colours and use these colours to fill in the sections in the letters of your name.
