Treasure Island Game

I can follow and give instructions involving position, direction and movement.

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the boat and place it on the start tile.
- 2. One child takes a treasure card from the top, keeps it a secret and directs the others to move the pirate ship to the object on the card.
- 3. Use positional and directional vocabulary, such as right turn, left turn, quarter turn, half turn, forwards and backwards.
- 4. Try to avoid the sharks.
- 5. If the boat safely reaches the object, the child may keep the treasure card, but if not it should be returned to the pile.
- 6. Repeat until the treasure cards are finished and the winner is the player with the most.
