Treasure trail

This Treasure trail starts at the bottom of Brambleton Avenue GU9 8RA

1. Turn left onto Upper Way. Look out for the bus shelter. What does it encourage you to do?
2. Continue to the crossroads (you have 2 clues to find here). What is the main difference between the 2 Upper Way signs on either side of the road?

3. From this point, how far is it to the town centre on bike?
4. Turn left onto Green Lane, continue before turning right along Greenfield Road. How many lampposts are there between the end of the road and the first house (No. 128) on the left-hand side?
5. How many leaves are there on the railings outside No. 114 (discounting the handrail)?
6. What colour is the front door on No. 100?
7. Which house still loves Christmas?
8. What time is the post collected Monday-Friday from the bottom of Little Green Lane?
9. Turn left onto Little Green Lane and walk up the right-hand side. What animal is the doorknocker on house No. 68?

10. Stop at Little Green Lane Bus Stop. If you caught the first bus on a Saturday (am) from Little Green Lane, what time would you get to Water Lane, Sainsbury's?
11. What type of leaf is pictured on the yellow grit box near the school?
12. What is the 1st instruction on the defibrillator?
13. How many WOODEN stumps are there on the right-hand side verge between school and Shortheath Road?
14. Turn right at the crossroads and proceed along the right-hand side. What is the name of No. 98 Shortheath Road?
15. What plant can be found on the Shortheath Crest Road sign?

16. Continue along Shortheath Road towards the bus shelter. How many steps lead from Shortheath Road to Shortheath Crest?
17. What number bus goes from the Waiting Room Bus Stop?
18. Look at the map in the bus shelter, what is located at point R?

We hope you have enjoyed the trail. You might want to draw a map to show where you have been. What features could you add to your map? Will your map need a key?
