We hope you are all keeping safe and well and have been busy this week. The children in school have been completing the same work set as those of you still at home. Hopefully you have been able to complete some of them.

Next week we will be learning more about people who help us. We will be thinking about real life superheroes who help us in our everyday lives, including our parents, teachers, doctors, nurses, firemen and police workers. This week we have two challenges for you. The first one is for you to learn your address and practise what you would say if you were ever in an emergency and had to call 999. The second challenge is to create your own emergency vehicle. Think about its features – sirens, hosepipes, ladders, bright colours. Children can use junk modelling materials or collage materials.

We will continue our phase 5 phonics next week. We will be introducing 4 new sounds as well as recapping those we already know. There are videos to watch which introduce each new sound (phoneme). They are videos suitable for EYFS and Year 1. Again, they are rather long so you may want to split it into parts or cut some bits out. Have a go and see how you get on.
