

COMPARING BIRD AND MAMMAL REPRODUCTION: STATEMENT CARDS

Use these cards on your Venn diagram to compare reproduction in birds and mammals.

Females provide most of the food and care for their young.	Eggs are fertilised inside the female.	Both parents provide food for their young.
Eggs develop outside the female.	Eggs grow into young inside the female.	They are warm-blooded animals.
Both parents look after the eggs.	Young leave their parents after a short time.	They produce eggs.
Sperm from the male fertilises the eggs.	They are pregnant for a long time.	They produce many eggs.
