Share a book for 10 minutes every evening before bed for a week.	Read 2 books by the same author.	On a day out, be in charge of reading road names, signs, leaflets and instructions. Read a non-fiction book.	Follow instructions to complete an activity (board game, cooking, craft).	Read a book (or a few chapters) that has been made into a film or TV programme. Then watch it. Which did you prefer?	Learn a nursery rhyme or poem to recite out loud.
