Read a book outside.	Register for the Summer Reading Challenge https://summerreadingchallenge.org.uk/ and try out some of their challenges.	Share an audio book as a family. Discuss the characters in the book.	Read with a torch under your duvet or in a tent.
Read a suitable book to younger children, or your family pet, for 10 minutes every evening for a week.	Read 2 books by the same author. Which one do you prefer and why?	On a day out, be in charge of reading maps and directions.	Read a classic story e.g. Wind in the Willows The Railway Children The Secret Garden
Read a non-fiction book. Create a quiz based on what you found out and run a family quiz night.	Follow instructions to complete an activity (board game, cooking, craft).	Read a book (or a few chapters) that has been made into a film. Then watch the film. Which did you prefer? Discuss the book/film similarities and differences with an adult.	Perform a poem you have learnt by heart.
