Dear Parents,

Our Year 6 did us proud as they completed six weeks of learning and transition work together. They enjoyed their send off last week which included a reflection assembly and a final Leavers' assembly. We were able to film this occasion so that the parents can enjoy the assembly too and this link was sent out this week. We are pleased to have welcomed Year 5 back this week and they settled quickly. We hope the children have enjoyed their picnics and seeing their friends for an afternoon. We are busy making safety and learning plans for September and below is a summary of the key things you as parents need to know. If we do have a period of lockdown in the future, then we shall prepared to provide whatever is necessary. We wish you all a restful Summer and thank you again for your close working relationship with us during lockdown/partial opening.

September

We are looking forward to running the school as close to normal as possible in September. The Government expects all children to return. Here is a summary of what will and won't be happening:

Plans

- Full classes being taught and the two classes being viewed as a 'Team' (bubble).
- Children will be sat side by side and forward facing in rows
- We are providing a pencil case and equipment for every child so they don't have to share
- Extra handwashing and gel throughout the day will continue as it is at the moment
- Playground space will be divided for the Teams
- BASE provision continues with their own social distancing measures in place
- CM sport for every class will continue
- External providers for extracurricular activities on site with their own social distancing and bubble arrangements
- Video assembly once a week watched in class to discuss the school's theme/value
- Full curriculum being delivered including music lessons

DfE information:

Coronavirus / COVID 19 - Travel Policy

To ensure the safe running of our school for our staff and families, protective measures have been put in place to help manage the covid-19 pandemic.

In September, you will be required to inform the office of any travel that you have made from a country or area that has been later been put into lockdown.

It is expected that you will be aware of any government restrictions applicable on re-entering the country and abide by this advice. The school will also be aware if a period of quarantine is required and will not admit anyone to the school building that this is applicable to.

Symptoms and staying away from school

You must not attend the school if you or any of your family are displaying any of the symptoms of Covid-19, you should remain home and isolate for 14 days.

The main symptoms are:

- A high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If a member of staff tests positive for Covid then the whole year group that the staff member works in will be sent home to quarantine for I4 days. The same will be true if a child tests positive for Covid.

Reports and teachers next year

We trust that you have all received your child's report. Please contact the office if you have not as there were a variety of methods of delivery this year. If you have a question about your child's report, please email their current teacher. Mrs Goddin is working out of the classroom for one year as she will be supporting children and groups that require support/catch up. This will be a very important role moving the learning and curriculum content forward.

Welcome

We give a warm welcome to Mrs Harrington, who after teaching elsewhere for a couple of years, is returning 'home' to St Peter's. We are very pleased to have her skills back in our team. She will be teaching Year 4.

We are also pleased to welcome Mrs Dodds and Mrs McGinn to our BASE team called Mini-BASE for nursery and EYFS children. They both bring a wealth of experience and knowledge of working with younger children.

Buddies - in new Year 5

We are asking the current year 4 children to write a letter of welcome to their new buddy, who is a new child to EYFS. Please can you bring your letter and maybe a picture if you would like to school on Thursday 3rd or Friday 4th September. We can then give them to the EYFS pupils when they start the following week. Unfortunately, due to the fact that classes will not be able to mix we won't be able to have the buddies together until we get further guidance from the DFE.
