

Maths 	<p>Follow the link to watch today's lesson https://player.vimeo.com/video/480324356</p> <p>We only want you to watch the video today, there's no activity for this lesson.</p>	
Throwing and Catching Challenge 	<p>Step 1 - Throw a ball (or a pair of socks rolled up or a small teddy) in the air and try to catch it without dropping it. See if you can do it 20 times. Can you do any more than that? Can you change hands?</p> <p>Step 2 - Can you add a clap whilst the ball is in the air? Can you add 2 or more claps?</p> <p>Step 3 - Throw the ball in the air, let it bounce then catch it.</p> <p>Step 4 - Throw the ball in the air, turn around and catch it. Be careful, don't get too dizzy!</p> <p>Step 5 - Throw the ball in the air, can you clap under one leg before catching it? Can you clap under both legs before catching it?</p>	
Phonics ai	<p>Watch the video for this lesson. We are learning the ai family today. Now try the 'Alternative spellings for ai' activity sheet.</p>	✓
2021 Challenge	<p>Happy New Year! We're now in the year 2021. How can you make 2021? Can you create it in lego, with pegs, paint it, collage it, or maybe make it in sand or twigs? We expect you can think of lots of ideas! Send us a photo of your creation.</p>	


