Winter in a bottle, jar or container



Jar, bottle, box or container



Leaves, twigs, stones, moss

Once you have your container go and explore!

1 Collect natural resources from the garden, woodland, pavement ($u\,se$ my picture to help find things you might need).

Indoors/outdoors

- 2 Next place newspaper or an old sheet on the floor and display your winter treasures (the natural resources you have found)
- 3 Then start to place your woodland/ garden treasures inside your chosen container.
- 4 Close the lid or cover your container, stand back and take a look at your winter display.
- 5 Now open it up and smell.

What can you smell? Did it smell like the outdoors?

Extension activity— Grab a piece of paper and pencil and write down words to describe what 's in your container.

Example ...dry twigs, brown leaves

You could also leave your container sealed and come back to it each day observing any changes. Inside you have created a mini eco system, see what happens.

Remember when you are outside ...Stop, Look, Listen and Smell

If its safe close your eyes it makes your ears work harder. Sit down on the floor and enjoy the feel and the smell of your surroundings.

Look at the trees, find shapes in the clouds.

Most importantly, when you 're allowed, **get dirty!**Good Luck Year 1, hope you enjoy your Forest school activity.
