7.  $38 \div \boxed{1} = 38$
8. True or false – there are 4 factor pairs for 16? False:  $1 \times 16, 2 \times 8, 4 \times 4$
9. What is the perimeter of a 7cm pentagon? 35cm
10. If a bakery makes 500 loaves every day and sells 375 loaves each day; then how many loaves will be unsold at the end of a week?  $500 - 375 = 125$  loaves left each day.  $125 \times 7 = 100 \times 7 + 20 \times 7 + 5 \times 7 = 700 + 140 + 35 = 875$  loaves unsold at the end of the week.
