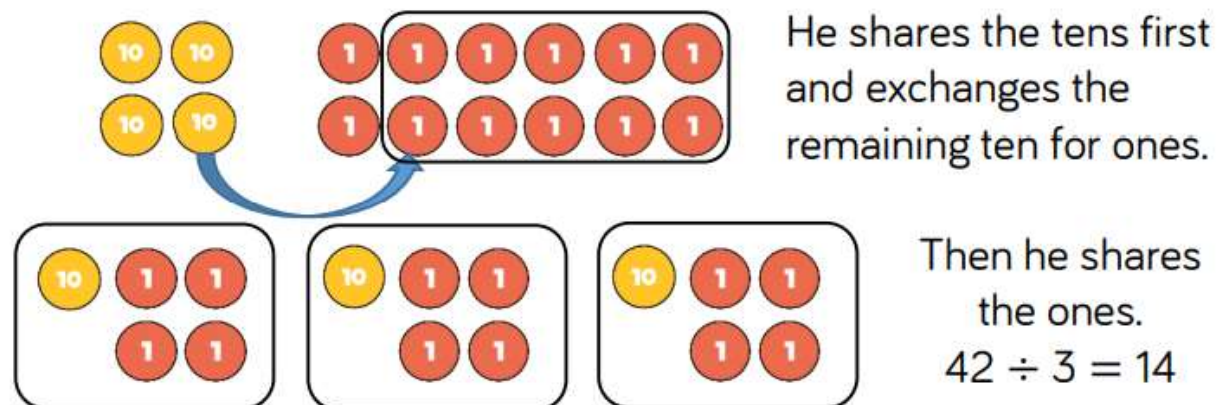

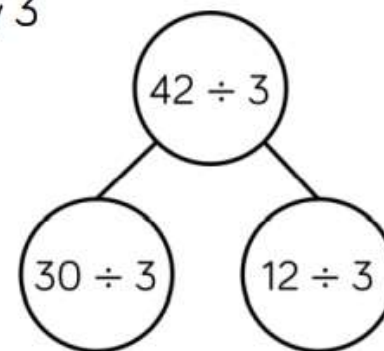
■ Ron uses place value counters to divide 42 into three equal groups.
