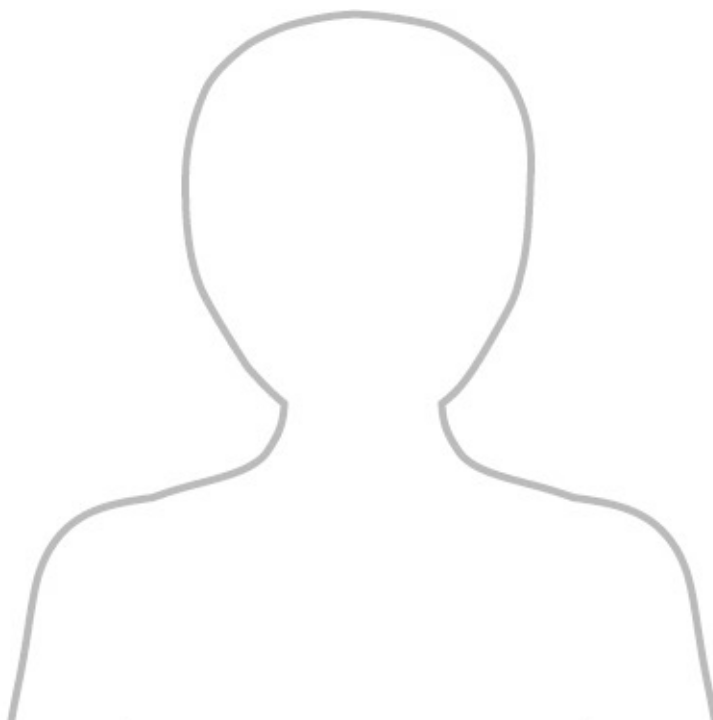

Do you like a particular music artist, band or genre? What is it about them you like?

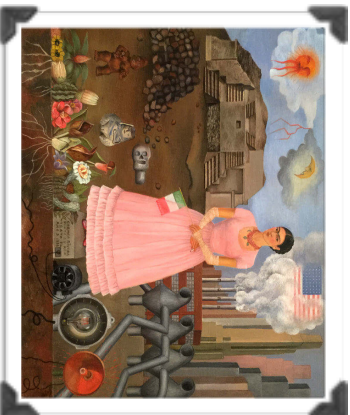
Are you part of any communities e.g. dance club, football club, fan club, school, hobbies?

Do you have a favourite book, author, film or TV show?

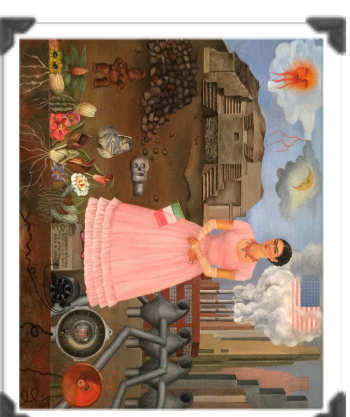
