Dear Year 5,

Well done for all of the hard work you have done so far – we have really enjoyed seeing your learning. This letter describes what we would like you to do this week. As a general rule we will be expecting you to send us one piece of maths and one piece of English on Friday by email (you will need to ask an adult to help with this). Work in other subjects (e.g. science, RE and History) should be uploaded onto Purple Mash. This week we will be marking Friday's maths assessment and the piece of writing about the arrest of Mr Tumnus. Please could you ask an adult to photograph these completed pieces and email it to the Year 5 email address (year5@stpeters-farnham.surrey.sch.uk). Mathematics and spellings will be set in the normal way on Friday.

You may have noticed that we are giving you the answer sheet to the maths learning (except for the day we have asked us to send you). We are trusting you to have a good attempt at the work yourselves, and then use the answer sheet to check how you have done, perhaps with an adult if they have time. Please do let us know if there are particular aspects which you are finding tricky.

During the day you need to make sure you are taking regular movement breaks. It is very important to get at least 30 minutes of exercise **outside**. Maybe try the Daily Mile with your adult or siblings and time your run.

We hope you have a good week, and we look forward to hearing from you!

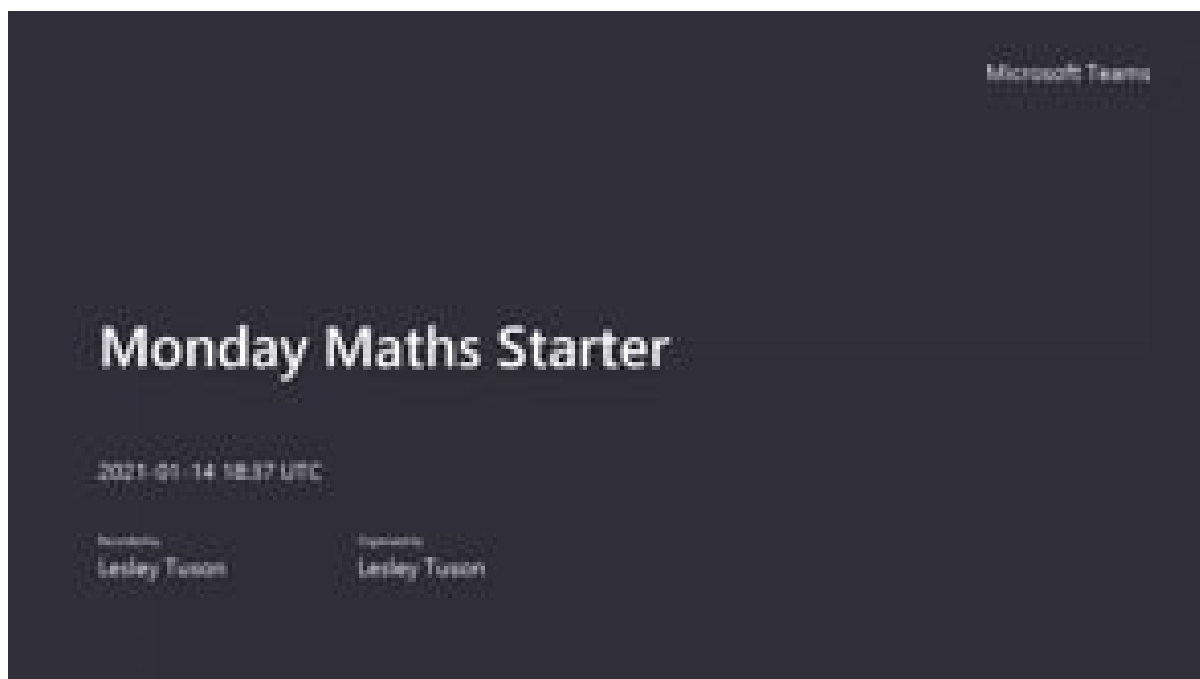

Computing

Over the next two weeks you will be creating a podcast to explain to someone how to find information on the internet successfully (you find useful and accurate information) and safely. A podcast is really just a recorded speech, with sounds effects. This week you can start to record your podcast, and add some sound effects if you want to. If you are in school we will be using Audacity to record the podcasts, but from home you can use any recording app that you might have on your computer, laptop or phone. If you are able to use Audacity (which is free and could be installed by an adult) then that would be good too.

However, some of the scripts I saw on Purple Mash were a little short and could do with some more material, so before you start recording, please look at the following BBC material, and then make sure your script is detailed enough.

Once your script is complete you can start to think about whether you would like to have sound effects or music as part of your script, and then start to record.
