We are trusting you to have a good attempt at the work yourselves, and then use the answer sheet to check how you have done, perhaps with an adult if they have time. It would be a good idea for you to do a little of this every day, particularly if you are not as fast as you would like to be around the keyboard.

### History

What was life like for ordinary people during the Shang Dynasty?

How do you think ordinary people lived during the Shang Dynasty? What do you think they did to earn a living? Where do you think they lived? What do you think they ate?

Read through the information on the slides about everyday life and how we know about how ordinary people lived.

The Shang Dynasty happened during the Bronze Age. This meant that people had learnt how to mine and use bronze but that they hadn't yet discovered iron and how it could be used. Bronze enabled people to work as bronzesmiths if there was a surplus of food.

Read through the Information Sheet called 'Everyday life in the Shang Dynasty'.

Write a diary entry or create a poster explaining the life of an ordinary person during the Shang Dynasty.

Think about...

- Where the person lives
- What they wear
- What they eat
- What kind of work they do
- Whether they have any special beliefs that affect their lives.
