### Prepositions

Prepositions link a *phrase* to a sentence, to do with...


time	place	cause
before	above	because
after	across	due to
at	behind	from
until	inside	for
since	up	

### Conjunctions

Conjunctions join **clauses**. Conjunctions can give meaning to the links, to do with...

time	place	cause
when	where	because
while	wherever	as
since		since

after		
until		

**Remember:** a clause must have an active verb.
