We're proud to report that you helped us raise a record-breaking £20,445 during the last school year.



As the average PTFA will raise £9,000 per year, we're surely in the premier league of PTFAs?!

Our largest fundraisers were the Summer Fair (£5,279.23) and Christmas Fair (£4,383.94), followed by our Fireworks Spectacular (£2,726.44) and Barn Dance (£1,662.77).

Last year's funds paid for a new sail shade in the playground, a polytunnel and equipment in the garden, as well as special educational needs books. We are now working hard to raise money for a new trim trail.

PTFA fundraising events would not run without our great team of parent (and teacher) volunteers - so a huge thank you to all who helped during the last year.
