
#### **WHY ARE WE FUNDRAISING?**



We are on the waiting list for a larger bin as it's been so popular.

We can recycle all types of clothing, accessories and household fabrics, including shoes, bags, belts, hats, gloves, bed linen, towels and sleeping bags. We generate 40p/kg or £400 per tonne.
