We are in the middle of Fairtrade Fortnight and in English and several other lessons, there is a focus on learning about specific products, the lives of communities and the impact that the Fairtrade premium has on them.

In order to support the learning in school, we are suggesting that your child finds out something about the product their class is studying.

- YR: Bananas (S America and Caribbean)
- Y1: Fairtrade flowers (Kenya)
- Y2: Chocolate (Ghana, Cote d'Ivoire)
- Y3: Coffee (Colombia, Uganda, Kenya and several others)
- Y4: Cotton (India, Bangladesh)
- Y5: Chocolate (Ghana, Cote d'Ivoire)
- Y6: Brazil nuts (Bolivia)

The countries are only examples. You may find others. We are adding some useful links to help you.

Find out as much as you can about your product.

- KS1: A colourful poster about your product.
- KS2: An information leaflet about your product (or a poster).

Remember to include:

- Where the product is grown?
- What do you want people to do after reading your message?
- What impact will it have on the farmers and their families?
